Dear Ms. Davis,

Thank you so much for your interest. Following please find some answers to your questions.

June 23, 2000: Tenet took immediate action against me as soon as I became the designated Medical expert on June 19, 2000 in a case of gross negligence filed by Donna Head and her husband against Tarzana Hospital, a Tenet Affiliate and a significant income provider to Tenet, Dr. Michael Vermesh.

Summer 2000, I did report the total lack of monitoring of the quality of care of Dr. Vermesh by this Tenet Facility to JCAHO, IMQ, CMA and the Department of Health Services when the hospital was undergoing JCAHO survey.

November 13, 2000, I provided significant data to the Headquarters of the FBI Healthcare Fraud Division in Los Angeles.

November 16, 2000, my clinical privileges were summarily suspended for non-existent alleged imminent danger. I had no patient at the Hospital that day and Tenet has not produced a single complaint from any patient for over 13 years.

February 2002, I proved to the Medical Board of California that Tarzana's report to the Medical Board was false.

That's why mainstream medical organizations became outraged by Tenet's conduct. Attached please find the Editorial and Article of the American Medical Association AMA-News of June 18, 2001, and my letter of February 21, 2002 entitled "The Rape of the Medical Peer Review Process by Tenet Health System".
